COMPULSORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT

1. Groin Guards (Males) and Mouthguards and WKF/AKF approved red and/or blue Mitts - All competitors except pee wees.
2. WKF/AKF approved red and/or blue combined Shin/Instep Protectors - All competitors.
3. Chest protection Females - Cadets (14 & 15 years), Juniors (16 & 17 years), Seniors & Veterans
4. WKF/AKF approved face masks - Cadets (14 & 15 years) and ALL Children (9 - 13 years)
5. WKF/AKF approved body protectors or body protectors provided by the organisers - Cadets (14 & 15 years) and ALL Children (9 - 13 years)
6. Pee Wee compulsory equipment. Body protector, WKF/AKF approved red and/or blue Mitts & Mouth Guard. There are no strikes to the head permitted.

General Information & Conditions of Entry

1. Entry Form must be completed honestly, accurately, legibly and SIGNED.
2. Use only one entry form per person. All Team Kata participants must be submitted on their individual forms.
3. AGE IS DETERMINED BY THE AGE A COMPETITOR WILL BE ON THE TOURNAMENT DAY
4. If under 18 years of age, entry forms must be signed one Parent or Guardian.
5. WKF (World Karate Federation) rules will be applied to this tournament and modified at the discretion of the tournament organisers. Some events may be officiated using the Judge Mirror System.
6. Competitors are responsible for their own Public Liability & Professional Indemnity Insurance including Participation (Member to Member) & Sports Injury / Accident cover.
7. Children/Cadets/Juniors may not enter more than one (1) age category.
8. Senior Kumite maximum age is 45 yrs.
9. * Veterans' Kumite 35 Yrs & Above – Competitors 45 yrs and above must supply a medical clearance with their entry form.
10. The organisers reserve the right to combine or cancel divisions where there are insufficient entries.

Conditions of Entry – Disclaimer

1. I acknowledge that I have read the definitions set out below.
2. I hereby acknowledge that my entry and/or participation in the Tournament carries with it a significant risk of personal injury.
3. Therefore, I for myself and the Releasors hereby relinquish, release and/or waive any action against the Releasees for any personal injury sustained by me arising out of and/or in the course of the Tournament whether as a result of any disregard and/or technical breach of any Rules of the Tournament or otherwise.
4. In addition, in the event of any action being commenced, I for myself and the Releasors hereby indemnify the Releasees against any cost and damages arising from or connected herewith.
5. I hereby authorise the Australian Yoseikan Karate Association Inc. or its nominated representative to capture photographic, digital or other electronic images during the course of this event. I further acknowledge that Australian Yoseikan Karate Association Inc. or its nominated representative owns all Intellectual Property rights in respect to these photographic, digital or other electronic images and may, at its sole discretion, publish, display or otherwise use these images for promotional purposes.

Definitions

- a) "Personal Injury" has its ordinary English meaning and includes any injury for which a person might be awarded under General Damages and/or Special Damages at Common Law.
- b) "The Releasors" means the family, dependents, heirs, executors and/or assigns and any person or persons claiming through them.
- c) "The Releasees" means any corporation, association or other body and/or any person(s) jointly and/or severally and whether servants or agents of any of the aforementioned or otherwise where any such corporation, other body or individual is associated with the promotion or conduct of the Tournament and includes competitor(s) referee(s) and observers or members of the audience.
- d) "Any Action" means any claim, right and/or course of action for damages at Common Law or pursuant to any statute.

OPEN KATA : Cannot repeat a kata in a consecutive round. **NOVICE KATA :** You can repeat the same kata consecutively in the Novice Divisions.

PARTICIPANTS : Participation certificate will be available at the competitor's entrance for those who have requested one.

ELIGIBILITY : You cannot enter the Novice divisions if you have won first place in a major tournament or won a medal at a National Championship. You cannot enter a novice division if you have won that division in a previous novice tournament. However you can enter a higher level division. e.g. If you have won the boys 10th-5th kyu you can still enter boys Novice all grades even though you are a 10th - 5th level. Once you win the Novice all grades division you can only enter open divisions in Yoseikan-Ryu Karate tournaments. This means that you cannot enter an older division. Kata and Kumite are considered as different disciplines.

NO LOSERS PEEWEE DIVISIONS

Competitors in Peewee kata divisions will be required to perform their kata twice. Kumite competitors will compete in 2 bouts. (1 minute each bout) Peeweess will only be permitted to score on the body armour. Attempting to score to the head is not permitted. **If you enter a Pee Wee Kata or kumite division you cannot enter any Novice or Open divisions. We have found that it is too difficult to program the event. Children are getting stressed because they need to be in two places at once.**
