A4, A5 12.30 hrs start katateam competition C1, C2 C3 13.00 hrs ceremony kata 13.30 hrs start kumite competition cat. B1, B2, B3 16.30 hrs start kumite competition cat. B4, B5, B6 18.30 hrs ceremony kumite
Kata	Cat. A1, A2 – free selection. Kata's can be repeated. In the final competitors must perform a kata which they have not yet demonstrated before In the competition. Kata's will be demonstrate at the same time by both competitors. Cat. A3, A4, A5 – free selection, no shitei kata. In each round another kata has to be demonstrated. A demonstrated kata cannot be repeated. Kata's will be demonstrate separately. Cat. C1, C2, C3 – free selection. Kata's can be repeated. There is no bunkai in the final.
Kumite rules	WKF protection rules for male and female. There is no mandatory face protection in the cadet or junior category. All competitors must have red and blue gloves, foot/shin protection and belt. Contest time category B1, B2, B3, B4 is 1½ minute. Category B5, B6 is 2 minutes.
Weight category	Open category. In case there are too many competitors there will be a + and – category. Note! If the weight on the competition day is not correct, it is not possible to join another weight category. To avoid disappointment, please inform your students correctly.
Coach rules	If there are more than 10 competitors, coaches can ask for an extra coach card. Please write the name of the coach and extra coach on entry list. During the competition day it is not possible to get an extra coach card. Coaching only allowed in the competition area in trainings suit.
Referee	We kindly ask to bring an official referee with you. Please provide names in advance on the entry form.
Important	The organizer of the Rotterdam Cup is not responsible for missing property and/or for injuries during the competition day. Participation is on your own risk.
