The history of Cyprus is among the <u>oldest in the world</u>. The first signs of civilisation traced in archaeological excavations and research date back <u>11.000 years</u> to the 9th millennium BC.

The discovery of copper in Cyprus in the 3rd millennium BC brought wealth to the island and attracted commerce from its trading neighbors. Yet, although geographically placed at the <u>crossroads of three continents - Europe, Asia and Africa</u> - and a meeting point of great world civilisations, Cyprus has developed and for centuries maintained its own civilisation. The Mycenaean-Achaean Greeks settled in the island between the 13th and 11th century BC. They introduced the Greek language and culture, both of which are preserved by Greek Cypriots to this day.

Cyprus is the largest island in the eastern Mediterranean a is situated east of Europe. The two main mountain ranges are the Pentadactylos in the north a the Troodos in central a south-western part of the island. Between them is the fertile plain of Messaoria.

Cyprus has long been a crossing point between Europe, Asia a Africa a still has many traces of successive civilisations — Roman theaters a villas, Byzantine churches a monasteries, Crusader castles a pre-historic habitats. The island's main economic activities are tourism, clothing a craft exports a merchant shipping. Traditional crafts include embroidery, pottery a copperwork. Cyprus is becoming a crossroad of offshore companies and a business center of the region.

Traditional local dishes include the \underline{meze} – a selection of appetizers served as a main dish, halloumi cheese α the zivania schnapps.











Cyprus is well known as the island of Aphrodite, the goddess of love a beauty, who, according to legend, was born here. **Pafos is the city of Aphrodite and the hosting city of our Karate event.**

Cyprus lies at a latitude of 34°33' - 35°34' North a longitude 32°16' - 34°37' East.

Cyprus has a Mediterranean climate: <u>hot, dry summers from June to September</u>, a mild, wet winters from November to March, which are separated by short Autumn a Spring seasons of rapid change in weather patterns in October, April a May. <u>Sunshine</u> is abundant during the whole year, particularly from April to September when the daily average exceeds eleven hours.

The population of Cyprus is estimated at 892.400 of whom 672.800 belong to the Greek Cypriot community (75,4 percent), 89.200 (10,0 percent) to the Turkish Cypriot community and 130.400 (14,6 percent) are foreigners residing in Cyprus.

On 1 May 2004 the Republic of Cyprus became a full member of the EU completing a long journey that lasted more than three decades. The President of the Republic of Cyprus signed the Accession Treaty on 16 April 2003 in Athens, Greece and on 14 July the House of Representatives ratified the Treaty of Accession unanimously







The currency of the Republic is the Euro - €, which is divided into 100 cents. Notes and coins currently in circulation are as follows:

Banknotes: €5, €10, €20, €50, €100, €200 €500

There are coins in denominations of $\in 2$, $\in 1$, 50 cent, 20 cent, 10 cent, 5 cent, 2 cent and 1 cent.

Banking

Commercial banks in Cyprus offer a wide range of banking services in euros, as well as in foreign currencies, and have correspondents in most major cities around the world.

The banking hours for the public are: Monday -Friday, 08:30 - 13:30. Banks are closed at weekends and on public holidays.

Banks at Larnaka and Pafos International Airports provide exchange bureau services on a 24-hour basis. Hotels, large shops and restaurants normally accept credit cards and traveler's cheques. Banknotes of major foreign currencies are also acceptable. Rates of exchange are published daily in the local press and are broadcast through the media.

A number of Automatic Teller Machines ATM operate on a 24hrs basis in central places of all towns and in Larnaka.

Hotels, large shops, restaurants, etc. usually accept traveler's cheques and major credit cards.

The supply in Cyprus is 240 volts / 50Hz. Sockets are usually 13 amps, square pin in most buildings.

More than one low current rating appliance may be operated from the same supply point, by using an adaptor (i.e. radios, electric clocks etc.).

The use of adaptors for operating high current rating appliances is not recommended (i.e. electric heaters, toasters, irons etc.).




