If you have won the boys 10th-5th kyu you can still enter boys Novice all grades even though you are a 10th - 5th level. Once you win the Novice all grades division you can only enter open divisions. This means that you cannot enter an older division. Kata and Kumite are considered as different disciplines.

### NO LOSERS PEEWEE DIVISIONS

Competitors in Peewee kata divisions will be required to perform their kata twice. Kumite competitors will compete in 2 bouts. (1 minute each bout) Peewees will only be permitted to score on the body armour. Attempting to score to the head is not permitted.

AGE - As per the day of the tournament - You can only enter the divisions within the age requirements. Competitors can enter a higher open category than their age with the approval of the tournament director. However competitors cannot enter the lower age category. Eg. if you are 13yrs old and wish to enter the Open Kumite 14yrs. You forfeit the right to enter the younger division.

Senior Kata 16 years and older - Senior Kumite 18 years and older.
