<b><u>Categories</u></b>	Individual Children Male and Female Kata & Kumite Individual Cadet, Junior Male and Female Kata & Kumite U18, U21 and U18+, Masters Male and Female Kata & Kumite U18+ Team Kata and Kumite.  <i>The consolation round and final are immediately after the category.</i>
<b><u>Rules</u></b>	WKF Rules + several adjustments of the Organisator Basler-Open. (Shobu System, Consolation round with Montreal-System).
<b><u>Responsible referee</u></b>	Ugur KOBAS (WKF/EKF Referee )
<b><u>Participation</u></b>	<i>The simultaneous participation in two or more categories within Kata or Kumite is not permitted.</i>
<b><u>Registration</u></b>	Registration can be made online over <a href="http://www.sportdata.org">www.sportdata.org</a> (Please check the special Link) until 25. August 2013 or with the form "reg_Form.xls" it can be downloaded from the webpage <a href="http://www.basler-open.ch">www.basler-open.ch</a> Registration after the date above, you get a penalty + Fr. 5.- to the start fee.
<b><u>Category correction, changes</u></b>	<i>Should there be less than 3 athletes in one category, they will automatically be classed in the next higher category, if possible to same age. Is the category already the highest category, then the athletes will automatically be classed in the next lower category.</i>  <i>Each winner is obligated to inform self the responsible tournament table immediately after each round.</i>
<b><u>Kata U10, U12, U14, U16</u></b>	Qualifying round and Final with flag-system.  <i>The number of Kata the athlete needs to present depends on the number of participants in the category. Tokui Kata (different Kata in each round). Each round has a different kata are shown. At least three different kata in the previous round was presented may not be shown. For example, first round Kata 1 and second Round Kata 2 third Round Kata 3. Then for 4th round either a circular another Kata or kata 1or2but 3cannotbeshown. During the consolation round the Tokui Katas can be chosen. For the 3<sup>rd</sup> place-determination and during the finals the athletes present their Kata one after another. During all other rounds the athletes present their Katas at the same time.</i>
	<i>Tokui-Kata according to the WKF list (+) additionally: Gekisai-Dai-Ichi, Gekisai-Dai-Ni, Heian Kata, Pinan Kata.</i>
<b><u>Kata Cadets, Juniors, U21, Seniors</u></b>	Qualifying round and Final with flag-system.  <i>The number of Kata the athlete needs to present depends on the number of participants in the category. If there are more than 17 participants the athletes need to present Shitei-Kata in the first two rounds (free tickets are counted as a round). From the 3<sup>rd</sup> round onward Tokui Kata (different Kata in each round). During the consolation round the Tokui Kata can be chosen. For the 3rd place determination and during the semifinals and finals the athletes present their Kata one after another. During all other rounds the athletes present their Kata at the same time.</i>

<u><b>Kumite</b></u>	<p>The weight categories will be determined on the basis of the registrations. Weight tolerance: +/- 1000 g</p> <p>Every participants needs to weight in before the category start.</p> <p>Should the weight tolerance differentiate more than + 1000g, the athlete is disqualified.</p>
<u><b>Kumite Fight duration</b></u>	<p>Child U10, U12, U14: 1.5 Minutes real Cadets, Junior, U18: 2 Minutes real U21, Senior, Master: 3 Minutes real (<u>Female 2 Minutes real</u>)</p>
<u><b>Children U10, U12, U14</b></u>	<p>Head (Jodan): <u>Touch is not allowed</u> (fist and foot techniques). Belly / Back (Chudan): Light touch of the "Gi" is permitted but not the contact to the body.</p>
<u><b>Equipment</b></u>	<p>The equipment must be WKF/EKF/SKF compliant.</p>
<u><b>Compulsory:</b></u>	<p><u>Dental</u> protection, <u>fist and foot</u> protection red/blue, <u>Shin</u> guard red/blue. Belt red/blue, <u>Cup</u> for male and <u>Chest</u> for female participants, <u>Body protection</u> for all athletes (U14 – U21, Cadets, Juniors, Senior).</p>
<u><b>Coach</b></u>	<p>Only companions with a valid Coach-card of the Basler-Open are allowed to enter the hall. Each club will get one Coach-card per 4 Competitors.</p>
<u><b>Protest</b></u>	<p>Protests have to be justified and handed in to the Basler-Open Referee Committee in written form. At the same time a deposit of Euro 200.- needs to be left. Should the protest be approved, the amount will be refunded.</p>
<u><b>Insurance</b></u>	<p>All participants must arrange their own insurance in the time period of the event. The Basler-Open organization and associations reject any responsibility. The organizer taking no liability. Each must provide sufficient assurance-protection for themselves and/or members.</p>
<u><b>Exclusion of liability</b></u>	<p>The organizer and Management accepts no kind of responsibility.</p>
