THE EVENT IS OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS OF JAPAN KARATE SHOTO FEDERATION HOLDING 3RD KYU OR ABOVE AND MINIMUM 12 YEARS OLD.

ANY FURTHER REQUIREMENTS?

EACH NATION WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE MIN. 1 REFEREE FOR EACH 10 PARTICIPANTS. ALL REFEREES MUST HOLD AN A. B. C OR D-LICENSE.

HOW DO I ENTER?

ALL REGISTRATION WILL BE HANDLED THRU SPORTDATA.ORG. SIMPLY VISIT THE SITE, FIND THE EVENT AND ENTER ALL RELEVANT INFORMATION. REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS 1ST JUNE 2014.

KATA CATEGORIES & RULES

Wheelchair Karate-do Championships

Individual Kata (Available to Disabled Individuals only)

Competition rules:

- All-age participants, male and female participate together.
- Preliminaries and final rounds will be judged by points.
- Preliminaries and final rounds may perform the same Kata.
- Preliminaries and final round are free Kata.

Preliminaries and final rounds Kata are to be chosen from the following Kata list: Shorin, Nirin, Sanrin, Yonrin, Gorin Kata

KATA RULES: JKS rules

All Kata will be judged by the following rules:

Individual Kata

Preliminaries, Quarterfinals, Semifinals:"Kohaku hoshiki" (flag system, red/white)

- both fighters performing kata at the same time
- Kata is to be chosen and announced by the Referee.
 Referee and judge panel: 1 Kansa, 1 shushin, 4 fukushin

Finals:"Tensu hoshiki" (points)

Referee and judge panel: 1 Kansa, 1 shushin, 4 or 6 fukushin

Team Kata:"Tensu hoshiki" (points)

Referee and judge panel: 1 Kansa, 1 shushin, 4 or 6 fukushin

JKS Rules for Ippon Shobu

KUMITE 10 - 11 Yrs old, 12 - 13 Yrs old, 14 - 15 Yrs old, 16 - 17 Yrs old

Semifinals: Ippon Shobu (1 Minutes 30 Seconds)

Finals: Sanbon Shobu (2 Minutes)

KUMITE Seniors

Preliminaries: Ippon Shobu (2 Minutes)
Semifinals: Sanbon Shobu (2 Minutes)
Finals: Sanbon Shobu (3 Minutes)

KUMITE Veterans (40-49 Yrs old), Masters (50 Yrs old +)

Round 1-2: Ippon Shobu (2 Minutes)
Semifinals: Ippon Shobu (2 Minutes)
Finals: Ippon Shobu (2 Minutes)

KUMITE Team: Ippon Shobu (2 Minutes)

There will be separate categories for men and women

Team KUMITE:

Men and Women separate categories, only one team pr. nation 3 fighters + 2 reserves

Kumite competitor's protective gear (Mandatory):

Protective gear is the responsibility of the competitor.

Hand mitts (White)

Gum shield (Clear type only)

Chest protectors for female competitors

Chest protectors for Kumite categories 12-13, 14-15, 16-17 years old

Groin guard is not mandatory
