Category correction, changes	Should there be less than 3 athletes in one category, they will automatically be classed in the next higher category, if possible in the same age level. If there is no higher category, the athletes will automatically be classed in the next lower category.
	Each winner is obligated to inform by himself the responsible tournament table immediately after each round.
Kata	Qualifying round with flag-system, two competitors at a time competing against each other.

In each round a different kata must be shown, at least **three different kata's.** The kata presented in the previous round may not be shown again.

For example: first round Kata A and second Round Kata B third Round Kata C. Then for 4th round either a another Kata or kata A or B, but C cannot be shown.

<u>Tokui-Kata</u> according to the WKF list (+) <u>additionally</u>: Gekisai-Dai-Ichi, Gekisai-Dai-Ni, Heian Kata, Pinan Kata.

Final and the 3rd place: The athletes present their Kata one after another.
